Around the Hood

Community Care - Cedar Crescent Park will see more landscaping activities this spring season, in part a project to replace the urban forest removed from the communities ongoing densification.

Often the work the CA undertakes is not immediately visible, we encourage you to join us in 311 service requests for things like graffiti cleanup, shopping cart pickup, and asking for assistance to address things like social disorder in our park spaces and trip hazards on uneven sidewalks. The adage See something - Say something applies not just to reporting crime.

To help our emergency responders, be bylaw compliant, keep the community looking good, and discourage problem social behaviour: if you live in a property with a lane or beside a walkway:

- add your address numbers to your rear fence or garage,
- weed and trim vegetation to 150 cm to the centre line of the lane or walkway.
- remove your recycle bins after collection day to discourage "transient traffic" and litter. If you do not have other causes that you support with your returnable bottles – consider the SC Community Association -free pick up from Skip the Depot- skipthedepot.com and select donate to the SCCA.

The Community Association needs volunteers to continue to help connect the community with information and opportunities.

If you have expertise, experience, are just keen to meet people, learn something new or just give back – we need to hear from you. As little as four hours a month for meetings on CA activities, contributing on a committee for responses to redevelopment proposals, volunteering on a day of an event or some time toward a "care" project: it all makes a positive difference in the community.
